All activity instructors to sign the risk assessment log sheet and document, their permit number and expiry date prior to the session starting. All activity instructors to have completed the Fanwood site specific activity training/familiarisation prior to running this activity. It is the instructor's responsibility to ensure that the equipment to be used is checked and is in a safe and usable condition. If in doubt don't use the use the activity and report suspected fault. Prior to session visually check to ensure the area is free of deleterious materials or trip hazards. Only soft arrows to be used for this activity and only in the designated area. 	
Overshot arrows / bruising and eye injury	All	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Barriers to be used as appropriate. Maintain a sensible clear overshoot area (10-20m). 	
Injury to participant(s) and spectators	All	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants to remain behind the activity area. Ensure a marked-out area is used and prevent access from non-participants at the rear of the shoot area. Arrows to be only pointed towards the target.

Participants' behavior	All	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If in the opinion of the instructor the behavior of an individual or the group as a whole is not conducive to running a safe session, then the activity session will be stopped and the person or persons causing concern removed. • No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should be allowed on the activity site. 	
Unauthorised use	All	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment to be kept in locked store. 	
Covid	All	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Government and scouting guidelines which are in force at the time the activity is run must be followed.
